

SUMMER ACADEMY 2011

Located at Lawton High School

This summer, Lawton Public Schools high school students in grades 9 through 12 may enroll in courses that are required for high school graduation and for college entrance. Math and reading classes are offered for the students in grade 6 who failed one of those courses. English, math, reading, and science classes are offered for students in grades 7 and 8 who failed one of those courses. Summer Academy is fully accredited through the state of Oklahoma, and credits received are equal to those earned during the regular school year. Lawton and area students are welcome to attend. Tuition for students who attend Lawton Public Schools during the regular school year is **\$140** per one-half credit, or session, or semester. Tuition for students who do not regularly attend Lawton Public Schools is **\$280**. Enrollment will be the first day of each semester at the Summer Academy site.

Orientation begins at 7:30 a.m. on the first day of Summer Academy at Lawton High School. Every student must be present at 7:30 a.m.

Driver's Ed. enrollment begins on March 1, 2011, and continues until all available slots are filled. Driver's Ed students must pre-enroll and pre-pay tuition on a first-come, first-served basis. To enroll, students must: 1. Provide a birth certificate and be 15 years old before class starts; 2. Show proof of reading proficiency at the eighth grade level; and 3. Pay tuition in advance at the Enrollment Center, 802 NW Homestead Dr, Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Driver's Ed. tuition is **\$145** for students who attend Lawton Public Schools and **\$285** for students who do not regularly attend Lawton Public Schools. Students will earn 1/2 credit as a high school course.

Summer Academy Students needing a first semester course for Summer Academy will enroll on the first day of Summer Academy, **June 6, 2011**, at the Lawton High School. Students needing a second semester course will enroll on the first day of second semester, **July 5, 2011**.

BUS SERVICE BEGINS ON THE FIRST DAY OF SUMMER ACADEMY AT 6:30 A.M.

Students who live in Lawton may catch a school bus beginning on the first day of Summer Academy. A bus schedule will be available the last week of May at all middle schools and high schools.
