

PROFICIENCY BASED PROMOTION INFORMATION

Only students who have been enrolled in Lawton Public Schools for six months or more may apply to advance to the next level.

A Proficiency Based Promotion Test allows students in grades one through twelve to demonstrate mastery of subjects, courses or grade levels.

In order to receive credit through Proficiency Based Promotion, students must pass two test components at 90% or higher:

(1) a criterion referenced test **AND** (2) and a performance component

HOW TO PROCEED:

1. Fill out the Proficiency Based Promotion application.
2. Complete a criterion referenced test in the subject area.
3. Complete a performance to demonstrate mastery in the subject/course/grade. (This portion will be judged by a panel of professional educators from Lawton Public Schools).
4. After successful completion of the test and performance, and after appropriate consultation with parents, students will be awarded credit and promoted to the next level.
5. High school course credit earned through a Proficiency Based Test will be counted toward high school graduation requirements regardless of the student's age or grade level.
6. The criterion referenced test will be administered at a Lawton Public Schools location.
7. A time for the performance portion of the test will be scheduled after successful completion of the multiple choice portion of the test.
8. Students must proceed sequentially through subject/course/grade.
