

About The Oklahoma School Testing Program

2011 Central Middle School OCCT Testing



Oklahoma state tests are used to assess student achievement; target student, classroom, and program improvement; and inform parents of student progress. The administration of the OCCTs fulfills No Child Left Behind (NCLB) and state mandates for testing, and Reading and Math test results are used for federal and state accountability requirements. The scope and general administration of the OSTP is

outlined in state law, 70 O.S. § 1210.505. Rules that govern the specifics of test administration and other details are available under Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 210:10-13.

Oklahoma public schools administer the Oklahoma Core Curriculum Tests (OCCT) and the Oklahoma Modified Alternate Assessment Program (OMAAP) in Grades 3 through 8 and after com-

pletion of specific high school courses. All state tests are aligned to the *Oklahoma Priority Academic Student Skills (PASS)*.

For the OCCT, Reading and Math tests are administered in Grades 3-8; Science, Social Studies, and Writing are given in Grade 5; Geography is given in Grade 7; and Science, U.S. History and Writing are given in Grade 8.
